Lorenzo Greco began evangelization in Germany in 1982...?

Lorenzo Greco started with evangelism in Germany in 1982. In 1986, he formed an evangelical fellowship in Fontaine Lévêque close to Charleroi in Belgium. In 1992, he got acquainted with the messianic work of Rabbi Paul Ghennassia. After that he had an evangelical fellowship in Péronnes-Lez-Binche. After having been adjacent for about 10 years to the fellowship of Beth Yeshoua in Brussels, he started to teach about Israel in his community. 90% of the members left the community. Then it happened that a new team of brothers and sisters formed themselves around him, most of them Italian. After the death of Anya Ghennassia and the retirement of Paul Ghennassia he was asked to take care of the messianic fellowship. Shortly after this Lorenzo discovered his Jewish -Beni Anusim- origins from Spain. His vision is to teach about Alijah, to love the Jews and pray for their salvation, the end-times and to encourage to witness and bring others to discipleship by new birth and to train leaders. In 2015, he founded a messianic cell group in the Isle of Reunion where 15 baptisms have taken place.



Emmanuel Rodriguez Perez was born in Oran in Algeria in 1960. After his theological studies for 5 years and rabbinic formation for 7 years he has been Rabbi of the messianic community El Bethel in Paris since 1999. He is also responsible for 2 messianic Yeshivas, one in Lausanne for the past 3 years, and one in Geneva, where Jews and non-Jews study together, for the past 5 years. He works together with Abdel Boudjakdji in mutual meetings of reconciliation between Jews and Arabs.



Peter Steffens has a fulltime teaching ministry, and together with his wife Vanessa travels widely within and outside the Netherlands where they are based. His teaching is enriched by his knowledge of biblical and modern Hebrew and Koine Greek, and the time he has spent studying under Rabbis in Jerusalem.
